Camp Times: 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
Ages 5 to 12*

*Children must be 6 years old by September 30, 2018 and cannot be 13 years old before May 29, 2018.

Camp Fees: \$25 per day, per child

At the time of registration, you may pay a \$25 (per child) registration fee and five days of camp per child. Registration fee is non-refundable.

Financial Assistance and In-Person Registration:

Online registration is NOT available for Financial Aid applicants. Persons interested in financial assistance, must first fill out the Financial Assistance Application available online and submit it for approval, along with the required documents. The deadline for Financial Assistance applications is April 27. Once approved, you must call to set up an appointment to come in person and complete your registration for the week of April 30 to May 4 or May 7 to 11, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Also, persons unable to register online may also call to set up an appointment to come in during the in-person registration dates.
